

## **How to Clean Optix UV-Filtering Acrylic**

There are some cleaning products that you should avoid because they can scratch or fog your acrylic. Use only a very soft damp cloth when cleaning acrylic surfaces. Do not use paper towels because they may scratch the surface. Use something soft like a microfiber cloth.

Never use any scouring compounds on your acrylic. Avoid ammonia-based products, like Windex or other home glass cleaners, because they contain harmful chemicals that will damage the surface, leaving it cloudy looking. Soapy water is safe and effective. Brilliance Plastic Cleaner is also a good choice for cleaning your acrylic and it comes with a microfiber cloth.

Never use the same cloth that you clean other household items with – it can retain dirt, grit, and chemical residues that may harm your acrylic items. We recommend using a new or separate cloth for your acrylic care.

If your plexiglass does get scratched, scratches on acrylic can be removed with Novus products. Should anything ever stick to an acrylic surface (such as an adhesive label or gummy substance) do not use any type of solvent. Instead, try soapy water or a product designed to be used on acrylic.
